

Sliabh Beagh

Overview

The Sliabh Beagh Way is a long-distance walk, 28.6 miles (46km) in length through remote mountainous regions of the counties Tyrone, Monaghan and Fermanagh. The walks offer the walker a variety of panoramic views, unspoilt countryside, bog land and forestry tracks. Whichever you choose, the sights and sounds of nature will soothe the senses. It is advisable to seek and plan accommodation in advance, as places to stay are limited along some stretches of the Sliabh Beagh Way.
